Curse

To speak badly to or of someone or something

Discerning

Distinguishing between opposites such as truth and falsehood or good and evil

Equal

The same as something else

Establish

To set up or start up something

Finish

To accomplish or complete

An evaluation of one's actions against a set standard/code.
