### **Alive**

### **Ancestor**

### **Bethlehem**

City where Jesus was born in a manger, a feeding trough for animals in a stable which is said to be a cave; Greek spelling of the Hebrew "Beth-lechem" meaning "house of bread" (See Micah 5:2, Luke 2:1-21)

### **Bribery**

A form of corruption in which one person offers something in exchange for something else in order to convince another person to do something

### **Citadels**

Fortresses within ancient cities that were used to protect rulers

### **Embark**

To get inside a vehicle or other means of transportation such as a boat or ship

### **Genuine**

Real; Authentic

### **Harem**

Group of women who belong to a king; Usually concubines

### **Harmony**

A balance in relationship amongst individual parts.
