Words Used And Their Definitions

Blaspheme

To make God look bad, attack God verbally, or take God's name in vain

Branch

A limb of a tree or other plant

Christ

A reference to Jesus, from a Greek word meaning "Anointed"

Christendom

A kingdom which is overseen by Jesus; Typically refers to a region where Christianity is the dominant religion

Conditions

The state of a place or situation; Terms of an agreement

Courtyard

A court open to the sky, especially one enclosed on all four sides.

Discerning

Distinguishing between opposites such as truth and falsehood or good and evil

Gideon

Son of Joash, from the clan of Abieezer in the tribe of Manasseh. Story is recorded in Judges 6-8 (approx. 1100 BC) where God called Gideon to fight the Midianites with a relatively small army.

Kneel

To get down on one or both knees

Marriage

A covenant made between a man and woman that lasts until the death of either person involved

Principle agent used in anointing oil; usually associated with one of the Magi gifts to the Christ child.

Overjoyed

Euphoric; Extremely happy

Partaker

A participant

Punish

To enforce a rule or law with penalties for offenses; To deal with someone harshly, with or without a legitimate reason

Sickbed

A place where one lies down while ill

Sparrows

Small brown or gray birds

Study

To examine closely and diligently in order to learn

Sustain

To keep something operating or living

Unbelievers

In the biblical sense, those who are not Christians

Unfathomable

Beyond imagination
