Betrayal

Act of "backstabbing" or to do something against a person's expectation.

Blood

A red liquid in most living creatures that is necessary for life

Bow

To bend at the waist towards someone as a sign of honour

Bronze

A metal made from combining copper and tin

Chaste

Morally pure; Modest; Celibate

Daunting

Overwhelming

Den

Dwelling place of a wild animal; Jesus referred to merchants in the Temple as a 'Den of thieves' (See Mark 11:15-18)

Determined

Decided or settled on something; perseverent

Encounter

To meet or come across something or someone; the experience of coming across or meeting something or someone

Intervene

To come between people to resolve a conflict or fix a problem

Millet

A type of grass grown as a grain

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Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

Pit

A large hole in the ground, often deep

Plunder

To take objects of value from a city or town during a raid; The items taken during a raid

Quote

Something that is said by another person word for word; To say something said by another word for word

Revival

A renewal and restoration of what once was; Usually refers to a return of a person or group of people to Christian faith

Sanhedrin

A Jewish council governed by a high priest that had authority to deal with criminal, civil, and religious affairs

Sepulcher

A grave or tomb

Servant

One who serves a master

Swarmed

A great number of things or people (usually refers to groups of bees)

Wardrobe

All of one's clothing

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
