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Words Used And Their Definitions

Abolish

To do away with; Put an end to; Annul: Make void

Afraid

Having a fear of something

Arrested

To be taken by law enforcement officials

Chalcedony

A translucent quartz that can come in many colors

Darkness

Opposite of light; Symbolic of evil, chaos and disarray

Disgraceful

Not deserving or showing respect; Dishonorable

Divorce

The end of a marriage relationship before a death of either the man or woman involved; To end a marriage; Jesus allows this only if someone is unfaithful to their spouse (See Matthew 19:1-12)

Fact

Something that is true

Flute

An instrument that is played by blowing into it and placing fingertips on keys or holes; Depending on the design it is played either upright or sideways

Perish

To do away with. To make non-existent. Also refers to a religious community.

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Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

Principles

Rules by which something works or operates

Prison

Secured area where prisoners are held

Religion

A system of beliefs and rules for personal conduct revolving around gods, God, or spirituality

Ruin

Destruction; A terrible end

Seal

Something used to sign a document using a symbol or emblem to make it law; A device used to close off certain places such as Jesus' tomb (See Matthew 27:62-66) and the scrolls (See Revelation 6); Something that secures documents

Serpent

A snake, often a venomous type; A reference to Satan (See Genesis 3)

Sin

An act of wrongdoing against God or others; an act of rebellion against God.

Slander

To speak falsely against someone in order to attack their character or reputation

Vessel

An object or person used to complete a specific task

The angered state of a person.
