Accused

Having been declared guilty of a crime, sin, or wrongdoing; People who have been declared guilty of a crime, sin, or wrongdoing

Actively

In a functioning manner or role

Atonement

Payment. God states in the Old Testament that sins can only be forgiven by a blood sacrifice. Throughout the Old Testament He hints to the coming of the Perfect Sacrifice. God Himself would take on flesh and once and for all pay for the sins of all mankind - past, present, future. Jesus Christ was perfect sacrifice and the only one that God will accept. God Himself paid the price for our sins and no other payment will be accepted!

Beggar

In the Bible, a person who is such poverty that they have to beg for necessities such as food

Blotted

Erased; Obliterated

Clutched

To have grabbed onto something

Counsel

To give advice; To discuss something with someone

Cursed

Opposite of blessed; Curse of the Law is one example and is usually death, be it physical or spiritual; The curse of the Law is the result of breaking it, not the result of the Law itself; Affected by a negative consequence of an action such as breaking a covenant

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Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

Desecrate

To defile a thing or place that is holy or special

Foiled

To have deceived or tricked someone; To have been deceived or tricked by someone

Free

Able to do something at will; At liberty: Ability to choose without restriction

Friends

People who are not hostile

Grace

The force by which God extends to all persons so that they may choose to live under his leadership.

Heaven

Presence of God; God's throne; City of God - gold is so common that the streets are paved with it. It has 12 gates named for the twelve tribes of Israel, wall has 12 foundations with the names of the 12 apostles; the height, width, and length of the city are equal.

There is no temple for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple; there is no need for light as God's glory provides all the light that is needed. See Revelation 21-22

Judah

One of the 12 tribes of Israel; The man who the tribe of Judah came from

Passover

A Jewish feast that commemorates the passing over of the angel of death in Egypt against the firstborns as the last plague against the Pharaoh before he released them.

Threshold

Frame of a doorway. Also the "tipping point" capacity of something.

Wait
