City where Jesus was born in a manger, a feeding trough for animals in a stable which is said to be a cave; Greek spelling of the Hebrew "Beth-lechem" meaning "house of bread" (See Micah 5:2, Luke 2:1-21)

Convictions

Beliefs or values that a person lives by

Intensely serious

Final

Having to do with an end

Hallelujah

Hebrew phrase meaning "praise the Lord"

Harlot

A female prostitute

Law

Regulations found in the first five books of the Bible, 613 total

Methuselah

Oldest living person to age 969 years old (according to Hebrew Bible tradition); son of Enoch and grandfather of Noah; tradition suggests God held off Flood until the seven day mourning of his death passed.

A people with the same origins, nationality, or ethnicity; A competition

Recommit

To reassert one's dedication

Salvation

Rescue; Act of saving or preserving from destruction or great calamity. The saving of mankind from sins and giving of eternal life with God.

Stewardship

Act of appropriately utilizing that which God has given.

Translate

To change a message from one language to another

Unswerving

Staying straight on a path; Not wavering

Wavering

To be swayed by external forces

Worldly

Of or pertaining to this world as contrasted with Heaven and the things of God; Earthly; Mundane

Wound

Damage done to living tissue; To inflict such an injury

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
