Ancient Roman device used for torture and execution by nailing convicted criminals to it. Used to scare people into submission by making a public example of criminals.

Debtor

A person who owes something to another.

Devastated

Ruined

Ephriam

One of Joseph's sons and the father of one of the 12 tribes of Israel, Ephraim

Escaped

Having left an area or someone's control

Excrement

Bodily waste

Inept

Absurd; Not fit to do something

Moses

A leader of the Israelites who brought them out of Egypt and gave them the Law or Torah; Credited with writing the first five books of the Bible

Multitude

A large amount of something

Priest

A Jewish office. A person who would intercede on behalf of the people before God and would represent God before the people.

Reconciliation

Settling differences; Forgiving someone of wrongdoing and restoring a relationship

Sentenced

To have given or have been given a punishment for a crime

Tithe

A portion of one's earnings given to God, usually to his workers (in Hebraic sense, it would have been the Levites; in today's context, usually means the church).

Unleash

To release

Wonder

Amazement or curiosity; To be amazed or curious

Word

The Bible; What makes up a language

Worth

Value, monetary or otherwise
