### **Against**

Opposed to

### **Aisle**

A space between seating in a church that allows for easy movement between the front and back of a sanctuary or chapel

### **Barren**

Empty; Lifeless; Unable to have children

### **Censer**

A container usually covered in which incense is burned, especially during religious ceremonies.

### **Compel**

To force or manipulate someone into doing something; To drive someone to take a certain course of action

### **Govern**

To control or dictate

### **Graciously**

To act with compassion towards another

### **Grips**

Having a firm hold on something

### **Journey**

A trip or travel

### **Judah**

One of the 12 tribes of Israel; The man who the tribe of Judah came from

### **Myrrh**

Principle agent used in anointing oil; usually associated with one of the Magi gifts to the Christ child.

### **Perilous**

Dangerous; Unsafe

### **Plague**

A deadly illness or disease that strikes an area; Moses with Aaron speaking performed ten plagues before Pharaoh (See Exodus 7-11)

### **Punish**

To enforce a rule or law with penalties for offenses; To deal with someone harshly, with or without a legitimate reason

### **Recover**

To regain a former and better state of being.

### **Shine**

To glow or be bright

### **Symbolically**

Representing something

### **Unprepared**

Not ready

### **Vipers**

Venomous snakes that travel in groups (called broods) and do not release their prey until it is dead; Jesus called the Pharisees a "brood of vipers"

### **Wonder**

Amazement or curiosity; To be amazed or curious

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
