Adversary

An opponent, rival, or enemy

Blasphemes

Attacking God's character; Using God's name in vain

Co-Heirs

A person who inherits something along with another person

Compassion

Showing pity; To have sympathy; Showing kindness beyond what is deserved or expected from others around you, often regardless of negative consequences

Concern

To worry or care about someone or something; An interest in or worry about something or someone

Dad

A man who has a child with a woman; A father

Damascus

A city in Israel. Most famously associated with the route between itself and Jerusalem in which Saul/Paul was converted by Christ.

Downcast

Directed downward, as the eyes

Exasperate

To frustrate or irritate.

Generous

Willing or eager to give freely

Goliath

A giant and soldier from the Philistine city of Gath who was killed by David with a sling and five smooth stones after being hit in the forehead; David fought Goliath while none of the Israelite soldiers dared to, refusing armor, and decapitated him after his defeat (See 1 Samuel 17)

Husband

A married man

Lame

Unable to walk; Jesus healed a paralyzed man (See Mark 2:1-12)

Majesty

Power, authority, or greatness attributed to royalty

Quench

To relieve, stop, or extinguish

Reigns

To oversee; To rule

Trade

To exchange

Transpired

To have happened or come about

Unleavened

Not to rise; typically associated with the kind of bread without yeast the Israelites were told to make when they fled Egypt.

Valuable

Having great worth

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
