Babylon

An ancient city in modern day Iraq; The capital city of the once great Babylonian Empire

Battalions

Large parts of armies

Beggar

In the Bible, a person who is such poverty that they have to beg for necessities such as food

Bishop

A position of authority in churches; From a Greek word meaning "Overseer"

Burden

A load to be carried; A responsibility; Any form of oppression or worry

Capstone

A high point

Contrary

Against; Not in agreement; Not supporting an idea

Cross

Ancient Roman device used for torture and execution by nailing convicted criminals to it. Used to scare people into submission by making a public example of criminals.

Deceitful

Dishonest; False; Having the intent to deliberately convince someone to believe a lie

Divorce

The end of a marriage relationship before a death of either the man or woman involved; To end a marriage; Jesus allows this only if someone is unfaithful to their spouse (See Matthew 19:1-12)

Egypt

An African nation along the south eastern part of the Mediterranean near Israel; Known for pharaohs, pyramids, its location along the Nile River, obelisks, mummies, gods with human bodies and animal heads, and the Exodus of God's chosen people

Followed

Imitated; Obeyed; Went behind someone to go where they go

Graciously

To act with compassion towards another

Holy Spirit

The promise of God's inheritance. The third person of the trinity. What empowered the apostles to witness for Jesus and perform signs. See Acts 2

Laymen

People in a church who are not clergy
