Addoni

A Hebrew name for God; Often used instead of Jehovah

Benefits

Being of an advantage to or helping someone; Advantages

Carnal Christian

A Christian who, despite making a commitment to Jesus Christ, continues to live with worldly values and morals. This in most cases is not a permanent thing; usually it is a transition from the old sinful life to the new life in Jesus Christ after being saved.

Cattle

Such animals together with the domesticated quadrupeds, as horses, swine, etc.

Destitute

Extremely poor

Eden

Original home of Adam and Eve, said to have been located in modern day Iraq. See Genesis 2:8-15

Equal

The same as something else

Euroclydon

A strong wind system that blows from Europe into the Mediterranean Sea; Usually referenced in Paul's shipwreck (See Acts 27)

Fishers of Men

A phrase used by Jesus while talking to fishermen on a fishing boat in the Sea of Galilee to explain what his followers would be led to do after pulling a net filled with so many fish their boat almost couldn't handle the weight

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

Grudge

Indefinite contempt or hatred for someone

Grumble

To speak against in discontent

Inheritance

Personal belongings or assets of a deceased person that are handed down to the children of the deceased; Hebrew custom states that the first born son is the only person to receive this

Jews

Members of the tribe of Judah or people who practice Judaism, the faith named after Judah

Justice

The correct administration of the set standard/code. The correction toward the set standard/code.

Legacy

The life and events of a person that can be remembered and have impacted individuals leading up to today. In the case of Jesus, His birth, death and resurrection have had the most important effect on humanity's relation with God. The act of Jesus taking our sin upon Himself has paved the way for us to once again have a right relationship with God the Father.

Mount Sinai

Mountain where God gave Moses the Ten Commandments (See Exodus 19)

Peace

Wholeness, completeness; Opposite of conflict

Pharisees

A Jewish sect in Jesus' time who believed to gain acceptance by God was to live separately from the societal norm. Typically a name of one who thinks too highly of oneself.

Repay

To return money or a favor
