Bind

To tie as a means of restraining someone or something

Cherub

Type of angel

Deacon

Today, a position of authority in churches ranking below the pastor, who is the leader of a congregation; The Greek word implies this person has the role of a waiter or host

Devote

To dedicate

Graves

Places where the dead are laid to rest

Happy

Opposite of sad; Showing enjoyment or pleasure

Harvest

To gather crops; The crops that are gathered

Infidelity

Unfaithfulness, usually to a spouse

Intercession

Prayer given on behalf of another person

Lame

Unable to walk; Jesus healed a paralyzed man (See Mark 2:1-12)

Misinterpreted

Having misunderstood a message

Nod

The land east of Eden, where Cain went; Hebrew word for "wandering"

Prevailing

Overcoming; Winning; Coming out ahead

Prize

Something that is won in a competition

Samaritan

A race of people in the New Testament who lived between Galilee and Judea in Samaria; A people group who were despised by the Jews.

Shameful

Disgraceful; Embarrassing

Strife

Fighting or conflict, sometimes violent

Supernatural

Spiritual, not physical. You can't see spiritual things with your physical eyes but you can feel and sense them. It's super (as in super-imposed) over the natural realm.

Trial

A court case; Something that causes trouble or suffering

Truth

Opposite of a lie; Anything that is said and is not false and / or without intention to deceive.
