Amen

An exclamatory expression of agreement.

Behavior

A person's actions

Branch

A limb of a tree or other plant

Census

A count of all people living within a certain region or nation; A census in the months prior to Jesus birth brought Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem (See Luke 2:1-7)

Conviction

An acknowledgment of something now believed to be true; an acceptance of something that was not previously accepted as true.

Courtyard

A court open to the sky, especially one enclosed on all four sides.

Endure

To suffer; To go through something; To continue

Follower

A person who follows another in regard to his or her ideas or belief: Of disciple adherent

Hades

Referred to as Sheol in the Old Testament, the place of shades.

Heaven

Presence of God; God's throne; City of God - gold is so common that the streets are paved with it. It has 12 gates named for the twelve tribes of Israel, wall has 12 foundations with the names of the 12 apostles; the height, width, and length of the city are equal. There is no temple for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple; there is no need for light as God's glory provides all the light

Protection

Rabbi

Jewish spiritual leader/teacher; Comes from the Hebrew word "rab" meaning "great"; means "my master" in Hebrew

Recruitment

The gathering of new members

Torture

To inflict severe pain with malicious intent; sometimes done to get information or in ancient times as a punishment for a crime or inability to pay debt

Transpired

To have happened or come about

Unforeseen

Not predicted or anticipated

Unleavened

Not to rise; typically associated with the kind of bread without yeast the Israelites were told to make when they fled Egypt.

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
