Bishop

A position of authority in churches; From a Greek word meaning "Overseer"

Blameless

To be without blame.

Captivity

Bondage; Slavery of the entire nation of Israel

Confident

Having a sense of trust in something, someone, or oneself

Crown Of Thorns

A crown made of a plant with long thorns twisted together used by some Roman soldiers to mock Jesus as "King of the Jews" (See Matthew 27:27-31, Mark 15:16-20, John 19:1-3)

Disobedience

Not doing as commanded

Distress

Pain, suffering, or misfortune

Empower

To enable someone; To support someone

Engulfed

Covered and surrounded

Establish

To set up or start up something

Foretold

Having predicted

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

Jericho

A city that Joshua led the Israelites to conquer while on their way to the Promised Land by marching around it and shouting to bring down the walls; its walls were thick enough to hold chariot races on top of and for people to live inside

New Testament

The last 27 books of the Bible; The new covenant initiated by Jesus dying on the cross

Paradise

Used metaphorically three times in the New Testament and describes the place where the spirits of God's people go when the die. Luke 23:43, 2 Corinthians 12:3-4 and Revelation 2:7

Parishioners

Members of a parish

Soul

Often the same as spirit, only of a person; Sometimes defined as mind, will, and emotions, whereas the spirit of a person includes the conscience
