Beheaded

To have one's head cut off; John the Baptist was executed in this manner by King Herod's decree (See Mark 6:14-29)

Dispute

To argue

Endurance

The ability to continue a strenuous activity

Entrust

To show confidence or trust

Eternal Security

A doctrine that states that once a person is saved he/she can not lose salvation

Fasting

To abstain from a particular behavior (usually eating food); as a spiritual discipline, for the purpose of gaining insights from God.

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity
