Bishop

A position of authority in churches; From a Greek word meaning "Overseer"

Carpenter

A person who works with wood

Deceitful

Dishonest; False; Having the intent to deliberately convince someone to believe a lie

Deposed

To remove from office; Dethrone

Egypt

An African nation along the south eastern part of the Mediterranean near Israel; Known for pharaohs, pyramids, its location along the Nile River, obelisks, mummies, gods with human bodies and animal heads, and the Exodus of God's chosen people

To check out something or look for evidence of something

Jericho

A city that Joshua led the Israelites to conquer while on their way to the Promised Land by marching around it and shouting to bring down the walls; its walls were thick enough to hold chariot races on top of and for people to live inside

Life

Existence on the physical or spiritual level

Nail

A metal spike; One was forced through the area below each wrist and one in each ankle of a victim of crucifixion

Obstinate

Sticking to an opinion despite all evidence to the contrary; Difficult to fix or get under control

Oppresive

Cruel, abusive, and / or overly controlling

Overseer

A supervisor; A person who watches over something in a governing role

Pardon

When we accept Christ as the the Only Way to God, surrender our lives to Him and ask Him to forgive our sins, all of our past, present and future sins are forgiven. They are thrown as far as east is from west and remembered no more. We are not held eternally accountable for them. God now sees us as sinless through Christ though we still sin and need to confess our failures. We will only be fully sinless after Christ changes us into our new form.
