Arrested

Battle

Believer

Someone who accepts a set of propositions, typically in a religious context; a commonly-used name for Christians who profess their belief in Jesus as Lord and Savior.

Blaspheme

To make God look bad, attack God verbally, or take God's name in vain

Briars

Small plants that have a woody and thorny stem

Caesar

A title used to refer to the emperor of Rome after Julius Caesar, who was killed by Roman senators because of extending his time in office past the allotted period set by the Roman government in 44 BC

Confident

Having a sense of trust in something, someone, or oneself

A flying insect similar to a grasshopper that travels in swarms and is known for eating crops; One of the plagues faced by the Egyptians (See Exodus 10:1-20)

Luxury

A thing that is not needed for survival but can be made available to those who can afford it

Miraculous

Describing an incident that has no rational explanation

Purpose

A reason for something being done; A reason for something or someone existing

Serpent

A snake, often a venomous type; A reference to Satan (See Genesis 3)
