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Words Used And Their Definitions

Anoint

To pour or smear oil on someone's head as was customary in ancient Israel to make them a king or priest (See 1 Samuel 16:1-13); To rub olive oil on someone's head for medicinal uses; To mark as being set apart for a certain purpose

Cattle

Such animals together with the domesticated quadrupeds, as horses, swine, etc.

Courtyard

A court open to the sky, especially one enclosed on all four sides.

Darkness

Opposite of light; Symbolic of evil, chaos and disarray

Dove

A white bird; often associated with Noah's Ark, peace, and the Holy Spirit

Embark

To get inside a vehicle or other means of transportation such as a boat or ship

Enemy

A person who is hostile to another; Opposite of a friend or ally

Enthusiasm

An act of doing with much excitement

Exile

To send someone out of their hometown or nation as a punishment for a crime

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Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

High Priest

All priests were descendants of Aaron when God created the priesthood and chosen by God to serve man in all things pertaining to God that he might offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins (see Hebrews 5:1) The High Priest was the only one who could go behind the curtain that separated the holy of Holies from the holy place in the temple. He could only do that one time per year and he had to follow strict guidelines while in there.

Hypocrite

A person who says one thing and does another; A pretender; A liar or deceiver

Jew

Descendant of Jacob; Nation called as God's people

Just

In Scripture this is a trait synonymous with honourable and fair

King Agrippa

A king who was almost convinced by Paul to become a Christian (See Acts 26)

Labor

Work

Life

Existence on the physical or spiritual level

Meditation

The act of reflecting on something

Recite

To say something from memory

Sword
