Showing pity; To have sympathy; Showing kindness beyond what is deserved or expected from others around you, often regardless of negative consequences

Deity

A being with divine presence.

Feeble

Weak; Frail

Glory

The splendor of something or someone.

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

Graves

Places where the dead are laid to rest

Heart

Capacity for sympathy, feeling, affection; Organ of the body responsible for pumping blood

Holiness

The quality or state of being holy

Holy Ground

A piece of land that has been set apart for a special purpose, most notably by God in the account of Moses and the burning bush (See Exodus 3)

Innocently

A place understood to be Hell

Leader

A person who directs the affairs of a group or organization

Moses

A leader of the Israelites who brought them out of Egypt and gave them the Law or Torah; Credited with writing the first five books of the Bible

Moses Staff

A rod that Moses used to perform miracles, including parting the Red Sea (See Exodus 14:21-22), the plague of turning all the water in Egypt to blood (not affecting the Israelites, See Exodus 7:14-24), and having water gush from a stone in the 40 year trek in the desert (See Exodus 17:1-7)
