## Words Used And Their Definitions

### **Alabaster**

A form of translucent gypsum

### **Chapter**

A section of a book of the Bible often indicated by a large number at the beginning of each one

### **Christ**

A reference to Jesus, from a Greek word meaning "Anointed"

### **Crown**

Head wear that symbolizes a head of state. Example: A King or Queen

### **Death**

The point at which a person ceases to live.

### **Desolate**

Abandoned; Gloomy; Lacking happiness or comfort

### **Disgrace**

To humiliate or bring shame on someone

### **Disguised**

To have concealed the identity of someone or something

### **Fooled**

To have deceived or tricked someone; To have been deceived or tricked by someone

### **God**

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

## Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

### **Heir**

The next in line to a throne or in equal to a ruler or king.  
Christians are often referred to this with Jesus in God's riches.

### **Lamb**

A baby sheep, often used in sacrifices under the old covenant; A term used to refer to Jesus if capitalized

### **Law**

Regulations found in the first five books of the Bible, 613 total

### **Maturity**

A point at which a person is fully developed

### **Nicodemus**

A Pharisee who talked to Jesus (See John 3:1-21)

### **Potter**

A person who makes pottery

### **Prophet**

someone speaking on God's behalf.

### **Purchase**

To take possession of through the exchange of money

### **Quote**

Something that is said by another person word for word; To say something said by another word for word

### **Reluctantly**

Hesitating to do something

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
