Almighty

Having the greatest strength or power possible; Immensely powerful;
Having the highest authority

Amen

An exclamatory expression of agreement.

Briars

Small plants that have a woody and thorny stem

Broken Heart

Hurt feelings

Capstone

A high point

Conformed

Obedient; Taking on the form of something else; Abiding by a set of rules to maintain harmony

Counsel

To give advice; To discuss something with someone

Darkness

Opposite of light; Symbolic of evil, chaos and disarray

Dismay

To bring discouragement and hopelessness

Farmer

A person who tends to livestock or crops

Having to do with an end

Future

Time that is to be or come hereafter

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

Integrity

Living virtuously before one's peers

Myrrh

Principle agent used in anointing oil; usually associated with one of the Magi gifts to the Christ child.

Omega

Greek symbol; usually refers to the other end of infinity

Parable

A short story used to teach a truth. They make heavy use of symbolism.

Pardon

When we accept Christ as the the Only Way to God, surrender our lives to Him and ask Him to forgive our sins, all of our past, present and future sins are forgiven. They are thrown as far as east is from west and remembered no more. We are not held eternally accountable for them. God now sees us as sinless through Christ though we still sin and need to confess our failures. We will only be fully sinless after Christ changes us into our new form.
