Adulteress

A woman who has been unfaithful to her husband. Jesus extended grace to the woman caught in the act of committing adultery. See John 8:2-11

The practice of placing a person in a tomb or grave as part of a funeral

Chastisement

Punishment with the intention to correct

Countenance

A person's composure; Facial expression of emotion

Devastated

Ruined

Downcast

Directed downward, as the eyes

Dwell

To live; To focus on

Exasperate

To frustrate or irritate.

Gladness

Happiness; Joy

Heart

Capacity for sympathy, feeling, affection; Organ of the body responsible for pumping blood

Jericho

A city that Joshua led the Israelites to conquer while on their way to the Promised Land by marching around it and shouting to bring down the walls; its walls were thick enough to hold chariot races on top of and for people to live inside

Jerusalem

A holy city in Israel

Journey

A trip or travel

Lyre

A small stringed instrument similar to a harp with a U-shaped frame that is played by plucking the strings

Peace

Wholeness, completeness; Opposite of conflict

Pierced

Thrust into something

Predestination

Maintains that God is the one who decides who will be saved (See Romans 9:16) and that it is not up to the desire of the person. (See John 1:13) God is the one who ordains the Christian into forgiveness. (See Acts 13:48) Also maintains God knew in advance those who would accept His gift of salvation. (See Romans 8:29-30)

Prisoners

People who are held in a jail or prison, usually for a crime
