Anxiety

Fearful uneasiness, worry, or concern

Apollyon

A fallen angel mentioned in Revelation who is supposed to be a destroyer (See Revelation 9:1-11)

Assuredly

Confidently; Without doubt

Atonement

Payment. God states in the Old Testament that sins can only be forgiven by a blood sacrifice. Throughout the Old Testament He hints to the coming of the Perfect Sacrifice. God Himself would take on flesh and once and for all pay for the sins of all mankind - past, present, future. Jesus Christ was perfect sacrifice and the only one that God will accept. Authority

Cross

Ancient Roman device used for torture and execution by nailing convicted criminals to it. Used to scare people into submission by making a public example of criminals.

Feast

To eat plenty of food, often as a way to celebrate; One of a few Jewish holidays if capitalized (Feast of Passover, Feast of Tabernacles, etc.)

Indignation

Anger caused by cruelty or injustice

Lamb

A baby sheep, often used in sacrifices under the old covenant; A term used to refer to Jesus if capitalized

Master

The person or thing a person devotes primary importance to; the person/thing which rules over a person.

Meditation

The act of reflecting on something
