### **Christ**

A reference to Jesus, from a Greek word meaning "Anointed"

### **Compassion**

Showing pity; To have sympathy; Showing kindness beyond what is deserved or expected from others around you, often regardless of negative consequences

### **Exempt**

To give an exception; To have been given an exception

### **Famine**

A mass food shortage

### **Give**

To hand something over to someone

### **Groans**

Moans that usually indicate pain, boredom, annoyance, or sadness

### **Grumble**

To speak against in discontent
