#### Guest

### Heir

The next in line to a throne or in equal to a ruler or king. Christians are often referred to this with Jesus in God's riches.

### Humiliation

Embarrassment; Putting someone to shame; Making a person humble

#### Iniquity

Sin; Evil; Wickedness; Missing the mark of God's perfection

#### Jew

Descendant of Jacob; Nation called as God's people
