Blotted

Erased; Obliterated

Chapel

Disguised

To have concealed the identity of someone or something

Excrement

Bodily waste

Forfeit

To surrender or give up something; To allow a loss of something to another person

Gnash

To grind teeth or bite at something

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Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

Golgotha

The place where Jesus was crucified between 2 criminals; name means "skull place" (See Matthew 27:32-44, Mark 15:21-32, John 19:16-27)

Guest

A visitor who is given hospitality

Hearken

To listen to someone; To pay attention upon hearing someone

Heir

The next in line to a throne or in equal to a ruler or king.
Christians are often referred to this with Jesus in God's riches.

Humiliation

Embarrassment; Putting someone to shame; Making a person humble

Iniquity

Sin; Evil; Wickedness; Missing the mark of God's perfection

Jew

Descendant of Jacob; Nation called as God's people

Manslayer

A person who kills another person

Pulpit

A place where a pastor speaks from in churches

Soul

Often the same as spirit, only of a person; Sometimes defined as mind, will, and emotions, whereas the spirit of a person includes the conscience
