Ancient

City where Jesus was born in a manger, a feeding trough for animals in a stable which is said to be a cave; Greek spelling of the Hebrew "Beth-lechem" meaning "house of bread" (See Micah 5:2, Luke 2:1-21)

Covenant

A significant agreement between two or more parties; usually is life-long or long-term

Crucifix

A Christian icon depicted as Jesus nailed to a cross

Determined

Decided or settled on something; perseverent

Doctrine

A teaching or belief

Egypt

An African nation along the south eastern part of the Mediterranean near Israel; Known for pharaohs, pyramids, its location along the Nile River, obelisks, mummies, gods with human bodies and animal heads, and the Exodus of God's chosen people

Envy

To want something that belongs to someone else

Eternal

Timeless; existing outside of time

Originally created for the devil (Lucifer) and his angels (Matthew 25:41). All people who reject salvation through Jesus Christ alone will be sent there and it will be cast into the Lake of Fire after the final judgment - the Great White Throne judgment (Revelation 20:12-15).

Humility

Opposite of pride or arrogance

Inflict

To cause pain or suffering

Life

Existence on the physical or spiritual level
