Mary because of the census at the time of Jesus' birth (See Luke
2:1-7)

A type of black birds used to bring Elijah food while in the desert (See 1 Kings 17:1-6)

Reap

To harvest crops

Ruined

Destroyed; Sabotaged

Sadducees

A Jewish sect in Jesus' time who didn't believe in an afterlife; this group were typically considered collaborators with the Roman occupying government.

Sanctification

The process of preparing someone/something towards holiness.
