Hebrew phrase meaning "praise the Lord"

Heart

Capacity for sympathy, feeling, affection; Organ of the body responsible for pumping blood

Invading

To use force in an attempt to take control over a certain location

Melchizedek

A priest and king of Salem; Little else is known about him other than that Abraham gave tithes to him

Perceived

Having observed and interpreted something with any of the five senses

Pronounced

Having said or declared

Sack Cloth

A type of clothing, particularly in the Old Testament associated with mourning or guilt.

Soul

Often the same as spirit, only of a person; Sometimes defined as mind, will, and emotions, whereas the spirit of a person includes the conscience

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
