### **Alexandrian**

People who came from a large city located in Egypt

### **Anoint**

To pour or smear oil on someone's head as was customary in ancient Israel to make them a king or priest (See 1 Samuel 16:1-13); To rub olive oil on someone's head for medicinal uses; To mark as being set apart for a certain purpose

### **Apology**

Expression of remorse for one's wrong doing

### **Authority**

A position of power; A person in power; The right to govern

### **Brittle**

Easily breakable

### **Carpenter**

A person who works with wood

### **Children**

People of a young age and have not yet reached adulthood; In Hebrew culture, a person's descendants regardless of the generational gap

### **Conqueror**

A person who overcomes something or defeats another person with force

### **Dead Sea**

A body of water known for its high salt levels near Israel

### **Dust**

Fine particles of dirt or debris

### **Envious**

Jealous

### **Establish**

To set up or start up something

### **Harbour**

To hold something tight within one's self

### **Life**

Existence on the physical or spiritual level

### **Pardon**

When we accept Christ as the the Only Way to God, surrender our lives to Him and ask Him to forgive our sins, all of our past, present and future sins are forgiven. They are thrown as far as east is from west and remembered no more. We are not held eternally accountable for them. God now sees us as sinless through Christ though we still sin and need to confess our failures. We will only be fully sinless after Christ changes us into our new form.

### **Plot**

A plan; A piece of land

### **Punished**
