Bondage; Slavery of the entire nation of Israel

Concern

To worry or care about someone or something; An interest in or worry about something or someone

Opposite of blessed; Curse of the Law is one example and is usually death, be it physical or spiritual; The curse of the Law is the result of breaking it, not the result of the Law itself; Affected by a negative consequence of an action such as breaking a covenant

Devoted

Having dedicated oneself

Fact

Something that is true

Fire

A way energy is produced as something burns; It had many uses such as cooking, a source of heat or light, and a way to offer sacrifices

Footstool

A piece of furniture used to elevate the feet

Golgotha

The place where Jesus was crucified between 2 criminals; name means "skull place" (See Matthew 27:32-44, Mark 15:21-32, John 19:16-27)

Guilt

Doing something that is wrong

The fulfillment of something that is needed or wanted

Scarlet

A type of bright red fabric used by the wealthy; A bright red color

Stewardship

Act of appropriately utilizing that which God has given.
