Boast

To brag; To give glory to oneself, another person, or God; To talk in a way that makes yourself excessively proud or arrogant (See 1 Corinthians 1:26-31)

Brothers

Male siblings; Equal members of a family

Canaan

The land promised to the Israelites after leaving Egypt

Creditor

A person who is owed money

Damascus

A city in Israel. Most famously associated with the route between itself and Jerusalem in which Saul/Paul was converted by Christ.

Delight

Pleasure or enjoyment

Edifying

To give significant meaning

Envy

To want something that belongs to someone else

Exempt

Exploit

An action

Flood

When waters overflow covering land; Sometimes referred to God's judgment (See Genesis 6)

Followed

Imitated; Obeyed; Went behind someone to go where they go

Foundation

Part of a building at the bottom that allows it to stand

Gate

A section of a wall that allows people and goods to enter and leave a city

Harem

Group of women who belong to a king; Usually concubines

Jericho

A city that Joshua led the Israelites to conquer while on their way to the Promised Land by marching around it and shouting to bring down the walls; its walls were thick enough to hold chariot races on top of and for people to live inside

Jerusalem

A holy city in Israel

Jews

Members of the tribe of Judah or people who practice Judaism, the faith named after Judah
