Accept

To take something that is being given; To come to terms with something

Captivity

Bondage; Slavery of the entire nation of Israel

Christ

A reference to Jesus, from a Greek word meaning "Anointed"

Creation

Something that which was made; usually refers to the material world constructed by God.

Cross

Ancient Roman device used for torture and execution by nailing convicted criminals to it. Used to scare people into submission by making a public example of criminals.

Embark

To get inside a vehicle or other means of transportation such as a boat or ship

King Agrippa

A king who was almost convinced by Paul to become a Christian (See Acts 26)

Kneeling

Resting on the knees

The act of following rules or regulations without understanding and applying the principles behind them.

Men from the East, most likely Persia, who visited Jesus

Meshech

A son of Japheth, mentioned in Genesis 10

A Jewish feast that commemorates the passing over of the angel of death in Egypt against the firstborns as the last plague against the Pharaoh before he released them.

Prodigal Son

Main character in one of Jesus' parables who runs away from home with his inheritance, squanders it, and then returns to his father thinking he will become a slave. But instead he is welcomed back with open arms by his father who celebrates his return. See Luke 15:11-32

Ravens

A type of black birds used to bring Elijah food while in the desert (See 1 Kings 17:1-6)

Reached

Attained; Stretched out to touch or grab something

Rejoice

To visibly show joy in circumstances. When people were healed by Jesus, those closest to them celebrated the miracles that occurred.

Scarlet

A type of bright red fabric used by the wealthy; A bright red color

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
