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## Words Used And Their Definitions

### **Abhor**

To hate or despise vehemently (See Romans 12:9)

### **Asunder**

Into pieces

### **Atonement**

Payment. God states in the Old Testament that sins can only be forgiven by a blood sacrifice. Throughout the Old Testament He hints to the coming of the Perfect Sacrifice. God Himself would take on flesh and once and for all pay for the sins of all mankind - past, present, future. Jesus Christ was perfect sacrifice and the only one that God will accept. God Himself paid the price for our sins and no other payment will be accepted!

### **Courtyard**

A court open to the sky, especially one enclosed on all four sides.

### **Escaped**

Having left an area or someone's control

### **Exceedingly**

Greatly or extremely

### **Generous**

Willing or eager to give freely

### **Gog**

A nation that is mentioned alongside Magog whose exact identity is unknown (See Ezekiel 38:1-39:24)

### **Instruction**

Teaching, often by demonstration

### **Instructions**

Directions to be followed; Teachings

### **Paradise**

Used metaphorically three times in the New Testament and describes the place where the spirits of God's people go when they die. Luke 23:43, 2 Corinthians 12:3-4 and Revelation 2:7

### **Pastor**

The highest position of authority in an individual church; a Latin word meaning "shepherd"

### **Perceived**

Having observed and interpreted something with any of the five senses

### **Plight**

A condition, state, or situation, especially an unfavorable or unfortunate one

### **Pulpit**

A place where a pastor speaks from in churches

### **Shalom**

Peace, wholeness, or completeness; Literally means "To destroy the authority that establishes chaos"

### **Shechem**

Town near Samaria; Was a place of various significant Biblical stories

### **Steal**

To take what does not belong to you without permission (See John 10:7-10)

### **Stricken**

Hit or affected by something

### **Temporary**

Not permanent; Only lasting for a certain amount of time
