Brimstone

Sulfur, a yellowish mineral known by its smell that's highly flammable; It is part of the atmosphere of hell and rained down on Sodom and Gomorrah while burning (Genesis 19:1-29)

Christ

A reference to Jesus, from a Greek word meaning "Anointed"

Cloak

An outer piece of clothing; In Jewish tradition, usually has tassels that symbolizes the Torah

Conceal

To hide

Court

Place where justice is dispensed and / or held

Diligence

Constant attention; Haste

Fasting

To abstain from a particular behavior (usually eating food); as a spiritual discipline, for the purpose of gaining insights from God.

Forlorn

Lonely from abandonment; Miserable

Haunt

To visit a place or someone as a ghost; To constantly remind someone of an event, usually negative; To happen often and spontaneously

Levite

Of the tribe of Levi, like the priests, but not of the Aaronic line. They served in the temple as song leaders, care taking of the temple and other services. Priest All priests were descendants of Aaron when God created the priesthood and chosen by God to serve man in all things pertaining to God that he might offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins (see Hebrews 5:1)

Promptly

Immediately

Prostrate

To lay down flat on the ground face down or to kneel and then bend forward face down

Sincere

Honest and straightforward; Truthful

Sing

To use the voice to make musical sounds

Slaughtering

Killing, usually an animal for its meat

Stubborn

Strongly unwilling to change something or take a different course of action; Difficult

Thief

A person who steals; In the parable of the Good Samaritan a thief beats a traveller and leaves them for dead (See Luke 10:25-37)
