Abolish

To do away with; Put an end to; Annul: Make void

Absolute

Without imperfection or impurity; Ultimate

Arrows

Projectiles that are launched from a bow

Christian

A person who practices Christianity

Continuously

Constantly and repeatedly

Earthquake

Massive vibrations caused by movement of large pieces of Earth's crust called tectonic plates that can form cracks on the surface called faults and can cause great damage to cities and buildings

Forbidden

Not allowed; Prohibited

Friends

People who are not hostile

Gnawed

To have chewed on or bitten at something

King Agrippa

A king who was almost convinced by Paul to become a Christian (See Acts 26)

Life

Existence on the physical or spiritual level

Master

The person or thing a person devotes primary importance to; the person/thing which rules over a person.

Messiah

Prophesied Jewish figure expected to restore the kingdom of God; refers to Jesus Christ.

Obstinate

Sticking to an opinion despite all evidence to the contrary;
Difficult to fix or get under control

Samaritan

A race of people in the New Testament who lived between Galilee and Judea in Samaria; A people group who were despised by the Jews.

Ship

A large vessel built for navigating large bodies of water

Slave

A person of the lowest socioeconomic class in ancient times, forced to work for those with more power and influence without payment.

Training

To process of teaching knowledge or skills; The knowledge or skills that are learned

Watchman

A person who watched from towers along city walls for enemy armies and warned the city when they approached

Wisdom

Ability to appropriately apply knowledge

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
