Death

The point at which a person ceases to live.

Defeated

To have beaten someone in a competition or struggle

Dismay

To bring discouragement and hopelessness

Eternal

Timeless; existing outside of time

Flesh

A part of us that rebels against God

Floodgates

Something that holds in or releases a large amount of flowing water
