Supposedly refers to people from town of Agag in Persia

Alexandrian

People who came from a large city located in Egypt

Clutched

To have grabbed onto something

Conspire

To plan something or devise a scheme

Conviction

An acknowledgment of something now believed to be true; an acceptance of something that was not previously accepted as true.

Danger

Possibility that someone can be hurt or harmed

Dismay

To bring discouragement and hopelessness

Generation

Group of people born and living about the same time (Currently usually within 30 year spans)

Goliath

A giant and soldier from the Philistine city of Gath who was killed by David with a sling and five smooth stones after being hit in the forehead; David fought Goliath while none of the Israelite soldiers dared to, refusing armor, and decapitated him after his defeat (See 1 Samuel 17)
