Blind

Unable to see, literally or figuratively

Buildings

Structures that are made for specific uses

Chastening

Giving a punishment

Christendom

A kingdom which is overseen by Jesus; Typically refers to a region where Christianity is the dominant religion

City

A large area with many buildings and people

Condemnation

The act of expressing disapproval

Dwelt

Lived

Flint

A type of stone often used for knives by the ancient Israelites in circumcision

Mordecai

Esther's uncle who adopted her

In the Christian context, the Messiah who's purpose is to redeem the world and re-establish God's purpose and intent.
