Bethlehem

City where Jesus was born in a manger, a feeding trough for animals in a stable which is said to be a cave; Greek spelling of the Hebrew "Beth-lechem" meaning "house of bread" (See Micah 5:2, Luke 2:1-21)

Buried

To have been placed in a tomb or grave

Cast

To throw

Creditor

A person who is owed money

Debt

Something which is owed to another.

Detracts

To deter one's focus

Egypt

An African nation along the south eastern part of the Mediterranean near Israel; Known for pharaohs, pyramids, its location along the Nile River, obelisks, mummies, gods with human bodies and animal heads, and the Exodus of God's chosen people

Fields

Large areas of land, often used for farming

Hunger

A need or desire for food

Personnel

People who work for an organization

Prophet

someone speaking on God's behalf.

Saviour

In the Christian context, the Messiah who's purpose is to redeem the world and re-establish God's purpose and intent.

Sparrows

Small brown or gray birds

Tear

To rip apart; A drop of water that comes from the eye

Terrified

In a state of fear

Unswerving

Staying straight on a path; Not wavering

Vineyard

A place where grapes are planted; Jesus used a vineyard in a parable to teach us of our salvation and His imminent return (See Matthew 20:1-16)
