To overcome an opponent or adversary

To thrive

To hand something over to someone

Haman

In the book of Esther, antagonist who attempted to wipe out Hebrew population

Handmade

Made or put together with the hands

Heart

Capacity for sympathy, feeling, affection; Organ of the body responsible for pumping blood

Infirmities

Illnesses or ailments

Life

Existence on the physical or spiritual level

A rod that Moses used to perform miracles, including parting the Red Sea (See Exodus 14:21-22), the plague of turning all the water in Egypt to blood (not affecting the Israelites, See Exodus 7:14-24), and having water gush from a stone in the 40 year trek in the desert (See Exodus 17:1-7)

Perish

To do away with. To make non-existent. Also refers to a religious community.

Perpetuate

To continue indefinitely

Posterity

A state of success for future generations.

Purpose

A reason for something being done; A reason for something or someone existing

Resurrection

Revival; Coming back from the dead

Slave

A person of the lowest socioeconomic class in ancient times, forced to work for those with more power and influence without payment.

Sleep

To be inactive and dormant

Snatch

To grab quickly
