The process of sending and receiving messages

To go on

Give

To hand something over to someone

Jericho

A city that Joshua led the Israelites to conquer while on their way to the Promised Land by marching around it and shouting to bring down the walls; its walls were thick enough to hold chariot races on top of and for people to live inside

Judgmental

Characterized by coming to conclusions about others with or without reason to come to a certain conclusion

Music

A combination of sounds made from instruments that may include singing

Philistia

Land on east coast of Mediterranean Sea; Home of Philistines

Proclaiming

To state (usually loudly) emphatically

Promised Land

The land God promised to the Israelites as they left their captivity in Egypt

Salvation

Rescue; Act of saving or preserving from destruction or great calamity. The saving of mankind from sins and giving of eternal life with God.

Sanhedrin

A Jewish council governed by a high priest that had authority to deal with criminal, civil, and religious affairs

Stranger

A foreigner or person who is not familiar

Trespass

To go into or on someone's property without invitation; To sin; To wrong a person

Troubled

Distressed, uneasy, or worried; Not calm or relaxed

Vows

A bonded agreement

Wept

Cried
