Cleansing

Congregations

Curse

To speak badly to or of someone or something

Death

The point at which a person ceases to live.

Generous

Willing or eager to give freely

Hay

Plants that have been cut down and used to feed animals

Heal

To restore, make whole

Hunger

A need or desire for food

Inn

A place of lodging for travelers; There was no room for Joseph and Mary because of the census at the time of Jesus' birth (See Luke 2:1-7)

Renounce

To abandon; To declare that one is abandoning something or someone openly

Samaritan

A race of people in the New Testament who lived between Galilee and Judea in Samaria; A people group who were despised by the Jews.

Shameful

Disgraceful; Embarrassing

Stricken

Hit or affected by something

Stumble

To trip or fall

Tabernacle

A tent used by the Israelites much like the Temple before God instructed the Temple to be built

Vessel

An object or person used to complete a specific task

White Horse

White Horse: One of the four horsemen in the book of Revelation usually referring to conquest or pestilence; There is debate whether this is a righteous figurehead or evil figurehead

Worthless

Without value

Yahweh

The name of God given to Moses in the book of Exodus at the burning bush. (See Exodus 3-4:17) It is claimed that nobody really knows what the word sounded like since Hebrew has only consonants in its alphabet and Jewish tradition long since then has not allowed the name to be pronounced. The Hebrew letters transliterate to YHVH (sometimes the V is said to be W). This name comes from a verb with

the root letters h-v-h. This verb is the same in meaning as the verb with the root letters of h-y-h, meaning to be or to exist. By declaring this as His name, He is declaring His sovereignty. The Hebrew ehyeh asher ehyeh means I will be whatever I will be. "Ehyeh" is the first person form of h-v-h in the future tense in English (I will be). Since Hebrew names are Hebrew words, it is likely the real name of God is Yihveh, the third person future tense of h-v-h.
