Able to do something at will; At liberty: Ability to choose without restriction

### **Glory**

The splendor of something or someone.

### **Guidelines**

Suggested parameters to operate within

### **Lamb**

A baby sheep, often used in sacrifices under the old covenant; A term used to refer to Jesus if capitalized

### **Led**

To have directed

### **Nations**

In Hebrew culture, the Gentiles; Countries

### **Net**

Rope that is tied in a way that enables it to catch fish when tossed off the side of a boat

Cried

### **Wretch**

A person who is seen as vile or despicable
