Abroad

In a foreign nation

Conscientious

Careful or cautious; Following the conscience

Contempt

Dislike or hatred

Convention

A gathering, usually of church leaders, that takes place at a set time and location

Endurance

The ability to continue a strenuous activity

Exaltation

Act of lifting someone / something into a realm of worship

Flesh

A part of us that rebels against God

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

Grumble

To speak against in discontent

Habit

Something that one gets used to doing and may do without giving a second thought

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Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

Harpist

A person who plays a harp

Heart

Capacity for sympathy, feeling, affection; Organ of the body responsible for pumping blood

Lonely

Feeling alone

Merry

Happy

Ophir

A port known for its gold and wealth; Its location is disputed

Paradise

Used metaphorically three times in the New Testament and describes the place where the spirits of God's people go when they die. Luke 23:43, 2 Corinthians 12:3-4 and Revelation 2:7

Reputation

A perception of a person based on what a person has done or accomplished or what has been said about that person

Scroll

Something that could be written on, rolled for storage, and unrolled to be read

Trial

A court case; Something that causes trouble or suffering

Wide Road

A phrase used by Jesus to refer to the path in life most people will take, it eventually leads to the destruction or demise of all who choose it (See Matthew 7:13-14)

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
