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Words Used And Their Definitions

Battalions

Large parts of armies

Bind

To tie as a means of restraining someone or something

Bitterness

A frozen form of latent anger and resentment. Often is an outcome of persistent emotional imbalance.

Crown

Head wear that symbolizes a head of state. Example: A King or Queen

Darkness

Opposite of light; Symbolic of evil, chaos and disarray

Despair

To lose all hope and confidence; hopelessness and loss of confidence

Doxology

A short song sung in many churches in praise to God

Gladness

Happiness; Joy

Maidservant

A female slave or servant

Mourn

To grieve, weep (See Matthew 5:4)

Mourning

Expressing grief; Weeping

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Words Used And Their Definitions - Continued

Prisoners

People who are held in a jail or prison, usually for a crime

Proclaim

To announce or declare openly

Seraphim

Six winged angels mentioned in Isaiah 6; Covers its face and feet with two wings each and flies with two wings

Shackles

Something that is placed around the wrists and / or ankles to prevent free movement, often used on prisoners and slaves

Sin

An act of wrongdoing against God or others; an act of rebellion against God.

Smeared

To rub something firmly onto something

Sovereign

To have complete reign over something or someone.

Splendor

Greatness; Something that inspires awe or wonder or shows greatness

World

The planet Earth; People or a civilization on Earth; People who live a life dedicated to their own desires and material things apart from God

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
