Babbling

Nonsensical speech

Bloodshed

Violence that causes blood to be shed

Condemnation

The act of expressing disapproval

Disobedience

Not doing as commanded

Disturb

To interfere with something or someone; To stir up trouble

Egypt

An African nation along the south eastern part of the Mediterranean near Israel; Known for pharaohs, pyramids, its location along the Nile River, obelisks, mummies, gods with human bodies and animal heads, and the Exodus of God's chosen people

Eternal

Timeless; existing outside of time

Falsehood

A false statement; Lie

God

His name in Hebrew is YHVH, often pronounced as Yahweh or Jehovah; Only deity worshiped by the Israelites; Main person of the Godhead in the Trinity

Gracious

Kind or courteous

Iniquity

Sin; Evil; Wickedness; Missing the mark of God's perfection

Leprosy

A deadly disease without cure and is characterized by crusty sores. It was greatly feared by most people in Bible times. Lepers were sent to leper colonies outside the city and if they came into town they had to wear bells so that they would know to avoid that person.

Moab

A kingdom near the Dead Sea

Pleasure

Something that is enjoyable

Proclaiming

To state (usually loudly) emphatically

Recite

To say something from memory

Reverence

A gesture indicative of deep respect

Set Free

To liberate; To have been liberated

Thief

A person who steals; In the parable of the Good Samaritan a thief beats a traveller and leaves them for dead (See Luke 10:25-37)

Translating

Conversion of words or statements from one language to another

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
