Arch Angel

A higher authority in angel hierarchy

Author

A person who writes; Jesus is referred to this when our faith is placed in Him

Bethlehem

City where Jesus was born in a manger, a feeding trough for animals in a stable which is said to be a cave; Greek spelling of the Hebrew "Beth-lechem" meaning "house of bread" (See Micah 5:2, Luke 2:1-21)

Christ

A reference to Jesus, from a Greek word meaning "Anointed"

Conditions

The state of a place or situation; Terms of an agreement

Dissension

Having different thoughts or feelings about an issue than another person or group

Dove

A white bird; often associated with Noah's Ark, peace, and the Holy Spirit

Evangelism

Sharing the gospel in any means

Fleet

The largest organization of war ships under the command of a single officer

A holy city in Israel

Life

Existence on the physical or spiritual level

Ophir

A port known for its gold and wealth; Its location is disputed

Parishioners

Members of a parish

Permissible

Not forbidden

Prophecy

Snare

Something that entraps and / or entangles.

Uplift

To encourage and/or inspire someone
