Lucky; Successful; Blessed

Gideon

Son of Joash, from the clan of Abiezer in the tribe of Manasseh. Story is recorded in Judges 6-8 (approx. 1100 BC) where God called Gideon to fight the Midianites with a relatively small army.

Glean

To gather crops left behind by reapers
